
Land & Water Activities

## Ebony Forest Reserve Chamarel

- "Ebony Forest" is a 50 ha conservation area for Mauritian endemic species with a rehabilitated indigenous forest (including rare semi-dry forest types), situated in Chamarel, in the south-west of <u>Mauritius</u>
- It was established in June 2017, after 10 years of work in restoring the forests and planting 130,000 endemic species. In addition to the reintroduced species, the reserve is home to some of the few remaining stands of original mature endemic <u>Ebony forest</u>.


## World of Seashells Museum


